

Policy of the management of Communicable diseases

If a child exhibits any of the following symptoms, he/she should not attend Just4Kids. If such symptoms occur at the JCC, the child will be removed from the program, and you will be called to take him/her home.

Severe pain or discomfort	Diarrhea	Episodes of acute vomiting
Sore throat or severe coughing	Stiff neck	Red eyes with discharge
Infected untreated skin patches	Blood in urine	Difficult or rapid breathing
Swollen joints	Skin rashes lasting longer than 24 hours	
Visibly enlarged lymph nodes	Yellow eyes or jaundice skin	
Elevated oral temperature of 101.5 degrees Fahrenheit		

Once the child is symptom free, or has a physician's note stating that he/she no longer poses a serious health risk to themselves or others, he/she may return to Just4Kids.

If a child contracts any of the following diseases, please report it to us immediately. The child may not return to Just4Kids without a doctor's note stating that the child presents no risk to himself/herself or others.
