



Member Code of Conduct Indoor and Outdoor Aquatics

The JCC is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all members, visitors, and staff. The Torah guides us: *Vinishmartem Mi'od Linafshotechem*, take vigilance in protecting yourself. In keeping with this important Jewish and universal value, we always ask individuals to act appropriately when they are on our campus or participating in our programs. We ask you to commit to abiding by the following practices and policies:

- Practice physical distancing. There is no congregating in groups on the pool deck that are not a part of your immediate family.
- Follow check in procedures and protocol as instructed. Please wait patiently with a minimum 6 feet distance with the person in front of you.
- Be prepared to sign a waiver, truthfully answer a few questions, and have temperature taken at check in. Once the waiver and code of conduct is signed once you do not need to repeat, but a health check is required on every visit to the facility including a temperature check.
- Wear a mask on campus and be considerate of others.
- Members must bring their own water. There will be no water stations available.
- Only members over the age of 12 will be permitted without adult supervision (18+).
- The building except for the bathrooms is not open or available to members currently. Anyone violating our barriers will be asked to leave the premises immediately and may be denied further access
- Locker rooms are for bathroom and handwashing only – showering and changing is not permitted, please come ready to swim and wrap to go
- All uses of the pool require a reservation, each reservation is separate and cannot be combined with any other. Back to back reservation of time slots is prohibited. Lateness exceeding 10 minutes may forfeit reservations.
- Cancellations must be submitted via our website under “Aquatics” and then “Swimming Pool Facilities” page. Cancellation must be submitted at least 2 hours in advance except for emergencies. Failure to cancel a reservation may result in a \$10 no-show fee billed to your JCC Account.
- Indoor Pool – NO congregating or deck observation children swimming will be permitted at this time with the exception of reserved Swim Lessons. All family members must be in the water with their family.
- Indoor Pool – No food permitted. Water in a plastic container is permissible. Water fountain will be closed at this time.
- Outdoor Pool - In the event inclement weather occurs while members are present, members will be instructed to head to their cars, there will be no congregating inside the fitness wing, family locker rooms or bathrooms.
- The JCC, through its CEO and Board of Directors, reserves the right to remove from the premises any individual not abiding by these practices and policies or acting in an inappropriate manner and further reserves the right to cancel the membership of any such person.

I have read and understand this code of conduct. I agree to abide by the rules described above and understand I may be subject to removal if I violate any of these rules.
