Registration & Fees:

To register, you must do so via the JCC Daxko registration system. A link will be sent at the time registration goes live and registration is strictly on a first come, first served basis. Once registration is completed and you have secured your spot, you will receive follow up information regarding additional forms required to participate in the program. You must register for each individual day. Pricing is based on your current membership status at the Katz JCC.

To ensure a smooth registration process, we encourage you to access the Daxko registration system in advance. You can do so by clicking [HERE](#).

To receive the JCC member rate for this program, you must be currently paying on an active JCC membership. If you have frozen, put your membership on hold or canceled due to Covid-19 you will be required to pay the guest rate. If you would like to reactivate your membership to receive the discounted member rate, please click [HERE](#). Please note that pricing may be adjusted after registration based on your *current* membership status.

Payment will be required in full at the time of registration.

Refunds:

In the event you need to cancel your child's registration, full refunds will only be given if the cancellation is within one week prior to the start of the vacation day. Any cancellation received less than one week from the start will be administered at 50%.

Health & Safety:

Health and Safety of our participants and staff is the highest priority.

Health Screening

Parents should closely monitor their children's health at home. If your child(ren) are exhibiting any signs and symptoms or are simply not feeling well, they should not attend our program.

All children and staff will go through a health screening each morning upon arrival before even leaving their car. Any child with a temperature of 100.4° or greater, and their siblings, will be sent home for the day. Please see the Drop-off section of this document for procedural information.

Face Coverings

Cloth face coverings will be required at all times during Vacations Days except when children are eating or appropriately able to distance for mask breaks.

Hand Washing / Sanitizing

Participants and staff will be required to frequently wash hands and hand sanitize throughout the day. At a minimum, children will be required to wash their hands:

- In between each activity period
- After each bathroom use, and
- Before consuming food.

Staff for each group will provide hand sanitizer to ensure easy access and frequent use.

A Day at a Glance:

Vacation days will begin with morning drop-off in the upper parking lot from 8:45am-9:15am. At 9:15am, participants will be escorted to their pavilion to prepare for the day and activities will begin at 9:30am.

Schedules will include a variety of activities such as sports, arts and crafts, miniature golf, and more!

Staffing:

Summer Fun Days will be supervised by Camp Directors Sara Sideman and Jared Kaufman and staffed by JSchool teachers and JCC Camps at Medford counselors.

Grouping:

Based on registration, children will be in mixed gender groups with peers of similar grades. Groups will be kept between 10-15 participants.

Rainy Days/ Inclement Weather:

With a limited capacity and the required smaller number of participants on each pavilion, we will be able to maintain a close to normal activities schedule during rainy days. Pavilions are stocked with a series of rainy-day activities and extra art supplies. In the event of exceptionally cold temperatures, children will utilize the camp dining hall space.

Lunch & Snack:

Families must pack a lunch for their child. **Please pack a kosher-style lunch and no nut products of any kind.** Lunches will be refrigerated upon arrival. Participants will receive an afternoon snack.

Pick-Up/Drop-Off:

All pick-up and drop-off will take place in the upper parking lot. Please follow staff directions upon arrival. Parents may not leave their vehicle at any time and must wear a face covering.

Required Forms:

Prior to the Vacation Days, you will be sent a Covid-19 waiver to complete. Participants will not be permitted to participate until this form is complete.
